



Lambeth Arena COVID-19 Protocol

All visiting participants and spectators must complete the City of London Health Screening using the QR code. The completed screening along with proof of vaccination (where applicable) must be shown to the city staff to gain entry. Those who do not have access to a smartphone can continue to use the paper City of London Health Assessment form (available at the arena).



****Arena is now at 100% spectator capacity. NO IN AND OUT PRIVILEGES****

As per provincial regulations, the City of London requires all spectators over the age of 12 to provide proof of vaccination. A current vaccination receipt and valid piece of identification are required for entry. Please visit the City of London website for full details <https://london.ca/VaccineProof>

Players must come dressed in full hockey equipment, with the exception of skates. Goalies may bring their hockey bag into the arena.

Teams will be allowed entry 20 minutes prior to game time. Teams must exit the arena promptly after their game is over.

Physical distancing of 2 metres must be adhered to at all times. This includes common areas, dressing rooms, and viewing areas. There is a maximum of 10 participants allowed per dressing room.

Masks are required at all times within the arena and in the dressing room. Prior to going on the ice, players may remove their mask. Coaches and bench staff must wear a mask.

Hand sanitizer must be used upon entry to the arena. It is recommended that participants also carry hand sanitizer with them.

Follow directional arrows and posted signage for flow of traffic. Participants will enter Lambeth Arena through the main entrance and exit through the back of the building.

NO outside food or drink is permitted into the arena including coffee, tea, etc. Players may bring a water bottle.

Showers are not available.
