Communication

- Changes to protocol and reminders communicated through website and parent/player emails

Facility

- Arrival/departure protocols
 - Parent/team representative must check in with City greeter to sign in on behalf of the group and confirm health screening has been completed
 - Bostwick Arena
 - Players will enter/exit arena using door south of main entrance
 - Participants to follow directional flow as outlined in Bostwick Arena Path of Travel map

 - City of London greeter will be present at entrance
 - Lambeth Arena
 - Players will enter/exit using main entrance
 - Participants to follow directional flow as outlined in Lambeth Arena Path of Travel map

 - City of London greeter will be present at entrance
- Availability of dressing rooms/showers
 - No more than 9 players should be in the dressing room to allow for physical distancing. Chairs will be available outside of dressing room for tying of skates
- Spectators/Parents
 - Players of younger ages requiring assistance with equipment will be allowed to have parent/guardian enter to tie skates
 - One spectator per player allowed in the designated viewing area
 - All parents/guardians entering the arena must complete City of London Health Screening form
 - All parents/volunteers must adhere to physical distancing guidelines and wear masks at all times while inside the facility
 - No congregating in common areas

Practice and Game Play Stage 3b

Session 2	November 21- January 22
Weeks 1 – 2	Developmental Skates
Weeks 3 – 10	One Developmental Skate plus one Modified Game per week

- Practice (Individual and Group Training)
 - Maximum of 25 participants on the ice, including coaching staff
 - Development ice divided into two groups of 12 participants
 - Full ice drills can only take place with 12 players on the ice at one time
 - Physical distancing required
- Game Play
 - Modified game play may begin after two-week development phase
 - Absolutely no physical contact is permitted
 - Benches require physical distancing of players
- Rosters
 - Each team will consist of 9 players plus one goaltender
 - Two coaching staff members (one coach and one safety person/trainer) will be on the bench for each game

Practice and Game Play Stage 3b- Session 2

- Teams are based on age group, but could be a combination of age groups based on registration numbers, there will be no try-outs for Rep/AE teams
 - Players will be divided into groups to allow no more than 25 participants on the ice including coaches
 - Groups will be based on last season's team (local league group and rep/AE group)
 - Groups will have 1 practice session and 1 modified game per week

Safety Guidelines and Reporting

- Prior to entering facility participants must complete the Digital Health Screening Check (no later than 30 minutes prior to session) through the SportsHeadz website health.sportsheadz.com
- All parents/guardians entering the arena to assist with equipment or as a spectator must complete the City of London Health Screening form <https://london.ca/sites/default/files/2020-10/City%20of%20London%20COVID-19%20Health%20Assessment%20Form.pdf>
- If the participant or anyone in the household is required to self-isolate, ALL members of the household must pause hockey activities until the isolation period is over
